

Doctor Who 4th Doctor Scarf - Earth Tone Scarf

Worn season 15-17

The scarf changed from season to season as damage had to be repaired and sections cut out. So no pattern is exactly the pattern. There is not one final pattern.

This pattern came off an old BBS back in the late 1980s. All the patterns I have seen since then for this scarf have been this pattern or a variation on this theme. According to the patterns at doctorwhoscarf.com this pattern most closely matches the season 16 scarf.

I recommend finding a good color photograph of the scarf to take to the yarn store with you.

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The Original Scarf

Needle size: 6mm (American size 9) or whatever size is needed to match the gauge.

Gauge: 14 stitches per 4 inches. 20 rows per 4 inches.

After blocking this scarf should measure about 10-11 inches wide and about 12 feet long. It will get longer with use.

Yarn - "double knitting wool" This term could refer to anything from light weight yarns such as DK or sport weight to the heavier, thicker yarns. Whatever yarn you choose, pay attention to your gauge and choose the needles that will give you the correct gauge for the yarn chosen.

- 3oz purple
- 6 oz camel
- 3 oz bronze
- 3 oz mustard
- 4 oz rust
- 3 oz grey
- 4 oz olive

Cast on 66 stitches.

The entire scarf is done in plain knitting or garter stitch with the first stitch slipped knitwise in each row.

I dislike weaving in the ends, so I tend to felt the ends together when I'm using wool and if not wool, then I use a Russian Join to join two yarns together so that I don't have ends to weave in, however both of these methods make it more difficult to have the color change in a specific spot, so if this matters to you, then you better join at the edge and weave in your ends.

For the purposes of this pattern, a row is once across the scarf. So 8 rows means that you will do 4 rows across and 4 rows back.

Finishing: Tassels on each end using all 7 colors, apx 4-5 inches long about a half inch apart.
