

Half Size 4th Doctor Scarf - Earth Tone Scarf

I wanted a Doctor Who scarf to wear at conventions but the full size ones are so bulky that they can be too hot in the summer and too much bulk to bother with in panels and workshop classes. So, I came up with this half size pattern. It's the same look as the real thing but scaled down to a more manageable length and width.

I recommend finding a good color photograph of the scarf to take to the yarn store with you to pick your colors from

needle size and guage depends on yarn chosen. I used Cascade 220 wool with #8 US needle. Start with the needle size recommended by your yarn manufacturer and adjust from there. Play with the needle sizes until you get the width and scale you like.

- Yarn colors
purple
tan (camel)
brown (bronze)
yellow (mustard)
red (rust)
green (olive)
grey

For the purpose of this pattern a row consists of once across the scarf. For example 6 purple would mean once across and once back 3 times.

The entire scarf is done in plain knitting or garter stitch with the first stitch slipped knitwise in each row.

Cast on 33 stitches.

- 6 purple
- 26 tan
- 8 brown
- 6 yellow
- 12 red
- 4 purple
- 10 green
- 4 yellow
- 14 tan
- 8 red
- 4 green
- 6 purple
- 22 green
- 4 yellow

Finishing: tassels with all 7 colors across both ends of the scarf, put a tassel about every half inch across.
