

Doctor Who 4th Doctor Scarf - Maroon/Purple/Orange Scarf  
Worn season 18

The scarves changed from season to season as damage had to be repaired and sections cut out. So there is no exactly correct pattern.

This pattern came off an old BBS back in late 1980s. The pattern states that it was given out on BBC stationery by The New Fantasy Shop in Chicago, IL.

I recommend finding a good color photograph of the scarf to take to the yarn store with you.

The 1980 season scarf

Needle size: 7 UK or 6 US or whatever size is needed to match the gauge.

Gauge: 18 stitches per 4 inches. 24 rows per 4 inches.

Yarn - The pattern calls for Sirdar Chenille acrylic/wool blend which is very difficult to find these days. Whatever yarn you choose, pay attention to your gauge and choose the needles that will give you the correct gauge for the yarn chosen.

6 Balls Sirdar Chenille, Terra Cotta/Rust, Color No. 523

8 Balls Sirdar Chenille, Claret/Wine, Color No. 525

8 Balls Sirdar Chenille, Aubergine/Plum, Color No. 526

12 oz Terra Cotta/Burnt Orange/Rust/Cinnabar

16 oz Claret/Wine

16 oz Aubergine/eggplant/dark purple/Plum

Cast on 42 stitches.

The entire scarf is done in plain knitting or garter stitch with the first stitch slipped knitwise in each row.

I dislike weaving in the ends, so I tend to felt the ends together when I'm using wool and if not wool, then I use a Russian Join to join two yarns together so that I don't have ends to weave in, however both of these methods make it more difficult to have the color change in a specific spot, so if this matters to you, then you better join at the edge and weave in your ends.

For the purposes of this pattern, a row is once across the scarf. So 8 rows means that you will do 4 rows across and 4 rows back.
